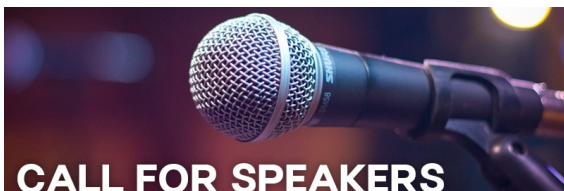

Funding for the REU program is intended to support student stipends, materials and supplies, and travel support for the students.

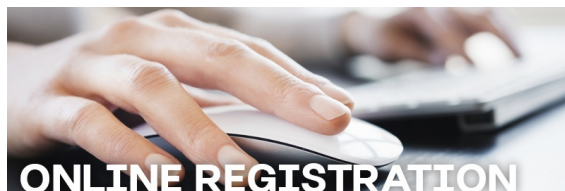
SC EPSCoR/IDeA Office will accept REU proposals **between Friday, February 24, 2017 through Friday, April 14, 2017.**
