



A Funding Opportunity to Stimulate Collaborative STEM Research

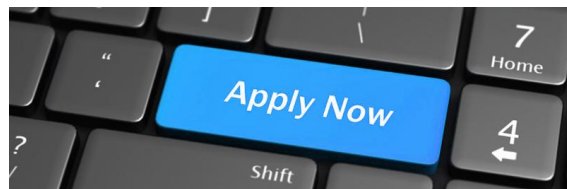
The SC EPSCoR/IDeA Program intends to release a Request for Proposals to encourage collaborative research in STEM areas among South Carolina institutions. This is an investment of \$1.2 million (total direct cost) to stimulate research that addresses state science and technology needs and increases the State's research capabilities to compete nationally. Up to four awards will be made. **Those interested in participating in this program should attend the free State Conference on Tuesday, April 4, 2017** to receive details and participate in discussions about the solicitation. The awards require collaboration among South Carolina institutions, and the SCEPSCoR/IDeA Office will host and facilitate meetings to build collaborative teams.
